In Our Forefather's Footsteps - The Future Generations Ride To Wounded Knee

RAPID CITY, SD - The Journey Museum & Learning Center announces the next event in its Fall Learning Forum series set for Sunday, December 10th at 2 p.m., titled, "In Our Forefather's Footsteps". This presentation details the history of the *Oomaka Tokatakiya* Future Generations Ride. The ride is an annual, 14 day journey on horseback that retraces the path made by Chief Spotted Elk and his people before the massacre at Wounded Knee on December 29, 1890.

"In Our Forefather's Footsteps" will take place in The Journey's Wells Fargo Theater. There is no admission charge to the learning forum on this day, but donations are appreciated and will be shared between the Future Generations Ride and Journey Museum & Learning Center. Presenters Alex White Plume and Kimberlynn Cameron will discuss their own experiences with the Future Generations Ride, including its origins and its impact on Native American youth. In addition, images and video from the ride will be shared.

Alex White Plume is the former vice-president and president of the Oglala Sioux Tribe. He helped develop the original memorial ride in 1986. Kimberlynn Cameron is a member of the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe. She participated in the ride for many years and is currently a student at SDSM&T.

This program features a forty-five minute presentation, followed by an open forum with questions and discussion about the topic.
