Be Responsible: Different museums have different rules, but we are a hands-on discovery museum so you are welcome to touch and feel designated displays. Handle gently any objects displayed for hands-on use. Any exceptions to this rule will be specially labeled. Avoid leaning on exhibit cases.

Be Respectful: You don't have to whisper but please use inside voices; quiet movements and voices will not disturb other museum guests. Please be courteous, walking behind rather than in front of others who are looking at exhibits. NO food or drink in the museum, theater or galleries. Please dispose of gum before entering. Please turn off or turn to silent mode all cell phones.

Be Safe: Museums can be confusing places to relocate your group quickly, so stay together and follow instructions for your group. Museums also protect lots of special things and are a place to learn and have fun, but it's not playground, so no running, jumping or climbing. Thank you.
