Iraqi Freedom combat veteran Shane Griffin shares his journey coping with post-traumatic stress disorder after coming home.

“When The War Ends: A Discussion of PTSD” Learning Forum will begin at 2 p.m. on October 22 in The Journey’s Wells Fargo Theater. Griffin, author of *The Things We Carry - A Story of War, Hope & Redemption*, will discuss his experiences overseas and lend advice to PTSD sufferers and caretakers.

Shane Griffin is an Air Force veteran who teaches at the Pennington County Juvenile Services Center. He lives in Rapid City with his wife and two daughters.

Learning Forums are thought-provoking presentations on a wide variety of topics. Each program features a forty-five minute presentation, followed by an open forum with questions and discussion about the topic.

Admission for Learning Forums is \$12 for adults, \$10 for seniors, \$9 for students, & half-off for members (includes museum admission).
